<p>Windmill:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">* He wants to build a windmill to help the farm. But if they have to work on Sundays* rations are cut in half	<p>Windmill:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">* He convinces them the idea* If they don't do this then Jones will come back
<p>Trade with humans:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">* He decides to do it* He only trades with Pilkington and Fredrick* They need resources for the windmill	<p>Trade with humans:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">* He has to convince animals that their memories are wrong* Law was never written down so it can't be one* fear is coming again
<p>Sleeping in beds:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">* Pigs are allowed to sleep in beds* beds = allowed sheets = not allowed. They are sleeping with blankets	<p>Sleeping in beds:</p> <p>Changes law from you can't sleep in beds to you can't sleep in beds with sheets.</p>
